EV & Lithium Battery Disposal Compliance Checklist – Dubai (2026)

This checklist helps contractors, fleet operators, and site managers comply with Dubai Municipality rules for lithium battery and EV waste disposal.

- Identify battery type and condition (intact, damaged, swollen, end-of-life).
- Isolate EV batteries from all other waste streams.
- Store batteries in fire-resistant, insulated containers.
- Never stack batteries without separators or padding.
- Do not mix EV batteries with construction or general waste.
- Book a Dubai Municipality–approved hazardous waste transporter.
- Ensure transport vehicles are GPS-tracked and fire-ready.
- Generate an accurate Waste Transfer Note (WTN).
- Declare battery condition correctly on the WTN.
- Capture clear photos that match the declared condition.
- Send batteries only to approved recycling or treatment facilities.
- Retain all records for inspections and audits.

WTN Tip: Photo mismatch and mixed waste loads are the top EV battery rejection reasons in 2026.
